Clinical Neuropsychology Services

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| Initial appointment (60 mins) Australian Psychological Society (APS) Item No. IOX (*negotiated from recommended rate \$251 p/h) | \$185.00 p/h |
| Assessment sessions (average 240 mins) APS Item No. NAX (*neg from RR \$236 p/h) | \$185.00 p/h \$740.00 (average)* |
| Comprehensive report APS Item No. ROX (*neg from RR \$236 p/h) | \$185.00 p/h \$1850.00 (average)** |
| Neuropsychology Feedback/Therapy sessions (60 mins) – optional APS Item No. SOX (*neg RR \$251 p/h) | \$185.00 p/h |
| Travel time (when required to travel to client) APS Item No. TOX (*neg RR \$50-\$145 p/h) | \$50-\$140.00 p/h*** (depending on time travelled) |

*This amount is based on the average length of an assessment. The assessment can be completed in one longer session or broken down into separate shorter sessions. Also, the amount and extent of assessment sessions required may vary from this depending on the individual, with some people requiring less time for assessment and some people requiring more, which would impact on the end cost.

**The comprehensive report may vary in length, requiring either less or more time to prepare, which would impact on the end cost.

***Travel to client when necessary amount varies depending on the length of time required to travel.

Please note that there is no Medicare rebate available for the neuropsychology assessment, however, I am registered to provide neuropsychological assessments for clients funded by Medicare for the DVA, and those funded by the TAC, provided they have the appropriate referral and/or prior financial approval. Also, depending on the nature of the difficulty, some funding for other clients may be accessible through various community organisations.

DVA

- I am registered with the DVA to conduct neuropsychological assessments for most DVA card holders, which are covered by Medicare funding. However, a valid referral is required by any on the list below, and financial authorisation must be obtained *by both the referrer and the neuropsychologist* from the DVA for most cases.
 - Local Medical Officer (LMO)
 - General Practitioner (GP)
 - Medical specialist
 - Hospital discharge planner
 - another mental health care provider with a current referral who is transferring the entitled person; or VVCS - Veterans and Veterans Families Counselling Service (VVCS).

TAC

- I am registered with the TAC to conduct neuropsychological assessments for clients who have *an active TAC claim no. and have obtained a referral and financial authorisation from their TAC care co-ordinator.*

***A Medicare rebate of approximately \$84.80 is available for counselling sessions, if a valid referral is provided by a GP or medical specialist. Please note there will be a gap. Out of pocket fee is around \$100.20, or \$50.20 for health care card holders.**
